Anyone can make a charitable gift in their will, but we do recommend you seek professional advice.

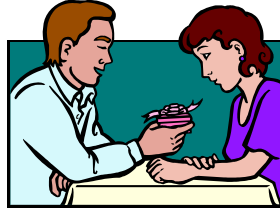
